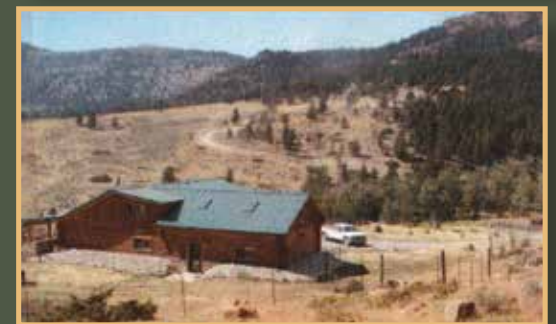

### PULASKI LEVEL - \$30.00

The Pulaski, invented by Edward Pulaski in 1911 is the most basic wildfire fighting tool that looks like a combination of a mattock for digging on one side, and an axe for chopping on the other.

### CHAINSAW LEVEL - \$150.00

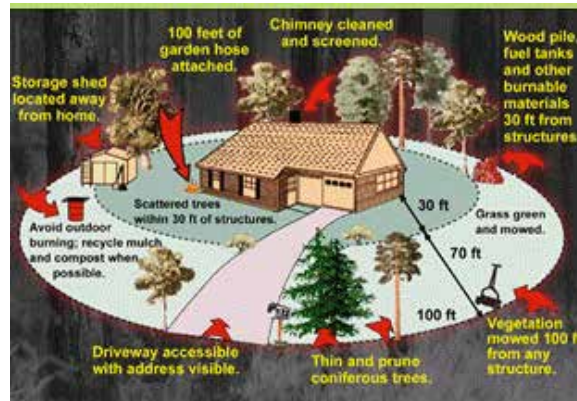
The chainsaw helps a firefighter to complete mitigation work much faster than working by hand.

### HOTSHOT LEVEL - \$500.00

The Hot Shot is a highly trained wildland firefighter who is typically first to arrive by air or ground.

### CORPORATE LEVEL - \$750.00
